

# **AFFILIATION AND ENDORSEMENT BY INSEA**

## **1. AFFILIATION**

Any national art education association is entitled to affiliation when the following information has been sent to InSEA and accepted as sufficient:

- a) A copy of the constitution of the organisation.
- b) A statement that includes the following:
  - That the organisation is actively related to visual arts or art education and has a democratic character;
  - Information about the conditions and categories of membership;
  - A list of the Executive officers and/or governing committee or council;
  - A list of inSEA members within the organisation.
  - A short description of recent activities, conferences and publications.

Applications for affiliation should be sent to the Executive Secretary of InSEA.

Affiliation gives the following rights and obligations:

- c) The organisation may include on its official documentation or literature the designation: 'Affiliated to the International Society for Education through Art', or 'Affiliated to InSEA', or 'An Affiliated Organisation of InSEA' (in English and any of the other official UNESCO languages: French, Spanish, Chinese, Russian, Arabic). Where in these designation stands 'InSEA' it may use the official InSEA logo (as printed in our letterhead). The organisation may not use the InSEA logo without the accompanying text, nor on other material or publications. National InSEA Societies may use their own letterhead in which the word 'InSEA' (with a small 'n') may be redesigned to fit their own style.
- d) When organizing a national, regional or worldwide activity, affiliated organisations in the same country are expected to cooperate.

## **2. ENDORSEMENT**

InSEA will give endorsement to a conference, exhibition, meeting, summer camp or other activity when:

- a) It is primarily related to art(s) education;
- b) It has an international character: This is the case when at least one of the following conditions is fulfilled:
  - Participants are actively invited from at least five different countries;
  - The organisation is the responsibility of at least two InSEA affiliated organisations in at least two countries on an equal base;
  - Representatives of at least five countries are giving a presentation;
  - International proliferation of the results is promoted;
  - Endorsements must be applied for at least six months before the event

An endorsement gives the following rights and obligations:

- a) The organisation may include on its official documentation, flyers, announcements or literature the designation: 'Endorsed by the International Society for Education through Art', or 'Endorsed by InSEA' (in English or in the national language(s)). Where in these designation stands 'InSEA' the organisation may use the official InSEA logo (as printed in our letterhead). The organisation may not use the InSEA logo without the accompanying text, nor on other material or publications.
- b) Announcement of the event through InSEA's publications (including the InSEA website)
- c) A (short) report for publication on the InSEA website.

The endorsement of an event gives no right to automatic endorsement of a comparable event. Each endorsement should be applied for separately. Applications for endorsement should be sent to the Executive Secretary of InSEA.
