**BIO:** I have devoted to visual art education near all my professional time in my life teaching from kindergarten to old people training in arts. I have been working as art educator from Kindergarten to Middle and High School. (2000-2003). Since 1999 until 2006 I was part time Lecturer in art education, Department of Art Education of the School of Fine Arts and the School of Education in the University of Granada, Spain. Since 2006 to the present, I won a position as full time Associate PhD. Professor of Art Education, Department of Art Education of the School of Fine Arts and the School of Education in the University of Granada, Spain. As researcher and scholar, I have also been visiting professor of doctorate courses (one intensive week yearly) in the School of Fine Arts of the University of Barcelona Country (Spain), 2009. Also, I have been visiting professor at University of Lapland (Finland), University of Studi Roma 3 (Italy), University of Aguascalientes (Mexico), University of Porto (Portugal), University of Antwerp (Belgium), in Erasmus Program of the European Union. For all this positions I was funded by European Union. I have been also Visiting Scholar in the Department of Urban Studies and Planning DUSP) funded by Fulbright Commission in the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (M.I.T.) since June to December 2015. The quality of my university teaching has been recognized in two teaching quinquennium, evaluated by the University of Granada. The quality of teaching is accredited by constant research effort dedicated to teaching: I have been the coordinator of three Innovation Projects in Teaching and participated in the direction of another. These four Projects Innovation Projects in Teaching have involved to more than twenty professors of University in Faculty of Education and Fine Arts School and were applied to more than 12.000 students. This project has been evaluated by a National Committee of Ministry in Education (ANECA) who approves it and funded it with a total amount of CAD 25.000.

**I HAVE BEEN ACTIVE IN INSEA OR RELATED ORGANIZATIONS IN THE FOLLOWING WAYS:**

My activity as leader has been centered in the development of research teams related to art and education in the University of Granada, coordinating two Master Degree Program since 2010. This Master Program join many of most relevant professionals in art education in spanish scope. I have been promoting research, diffusion and educational cooperation in arts and education in different social contexts: from Senegal (2001), Granada (2006-2016), Sudan (2002) and Honduras (2014-2016). I have been participating in National and International Congresses in InSEA, from New York, 2002 to Australia, 2015. Nowadays I am sharing an international project funded by SSHRC of Canada on Arts Based And Artistic Research in arts education.

**SHOULD I BE ELECTED I HOPE TO:**

If I were elected, I hope to help to Spanish speakers all around the world to integrate themselves in the InSEA network of art educators. In the last two years, in our group of research and teaching at the University of Granada, we have been centered in create links between Central and South America countries (México, El Salvador, Brazil and Honduras). We are now developing an educational cooperation project in Honduras alongside health and violence prevention programs.
