Notes from the President

As this World Council nears the end of its second year in office, unfortunately we are still in the grip of a global pandemic that has curtailed our normal activities of getting together around the world. As long as I have been a member of InSEA, I can't remember a time when two years have passed without a major conference, it is no exaggeration to say this is an unprecedented situation. However, members of the Executive Board and World Council have been working very hard to provide our members with a professional programme of events and opportunities, some of which I report in this edition of the InSEA members' e-news.

First however, I should welcome our new members from all around the world including China, Korea, Japan, Finland, England, Scotland, Ireland, The Netherlands, Cyprus, Greece, Spain, Portugal, Egypt, Australia, New Zealand, India, Chile, Canada, the US and Russia (I apologise if I missed your country!).

In this issue, please note the upcoming events – which are mostly online – especially the European Congress in July and the Latin American Regional Congress in November. Don't forget our InSEA endorsed congress in Egypt too!

Our new website is still under development and we are now entering a testing phase. I am extremely grateful to all the members of World Council and beyond who have given so generously of their time and expertise with this major task. Please check your membership status in case you need to renew soon. The new site will have different sections only for members – so you will need to set a new password – but more on that later. The InSEA Regional Webinar Series has been a huge success and I want to thank everyone who made these important events possible. I am convinced that we have reached many people in sectors of the art education community that we would not normally reach in face to face events: to quote Einstein, in the middle of adversity there is great opportunity.

In other news, the first two Emerging Leaders in Education through Art have been appointed – congratulations Viola and Moira!! InSEA publications is going from strength to strength with many books in press and several endorsed publications – we have also gained some new members by this route. The first (open to members) InSEA Café took place in May and there will be more of these informal events announced in future e-news issues.

Finally, InSEA is an official partner in a major research project and will publish a book of case studies from another (see breaking news).

Thank you to all our members for maintaining InSEA as a welcoming, inclusive, vibrant and creative community!

- Voice: Its Place in Art Education



Artists and Botanical gardens - Creating and Developing Educational innovations (ABCDE)

InSEA is participating as a key partner in this (Erasmus+) project (April 2021 – March 2023), an attempt to integrate experiential learning, participatory pedagogy and artistic actions in Botanical Gardens to create innovative educational material for primary schools. This material will combine creativity and in-depth analysis of the natural world providing teachers with tools to increase student engagement and interest in natural sciences and sustainability. To use experiential learning in Botanical Gardens as a pedagogical tool results in more engaged students, diverse learning opportunities, and aesthetical experience. Countries involved; Iceland, Ireland and Lithuania.

The project will create dialogue between natural science, artists and teachers has the potential of creating settings for experiential learning and participatory pedagogy for in-service art and natural science (or class room) teachers. They will be working with artists and natural scientists creating assignments that are based on the UN SDGs.

Benefits to InSEA include finance, influence in sectors beyond universities, for example, in the natural sciences, elementary and high schools and Botanic Gardens. InSEA will also gain (funded) new members from the artist-educator participants in each of the countries. In addition, we will facilitate the dissemination of good practices via InSEA publications. InSEA members, especially in the countries concerned, can get involved by attending one of the conferences or by submitting to one of the associated publications.


Acting on the Margins: Arts as Social Sculpture (AMASS) project





The **AMASS project** (2020–2023) investigates how the arts can act as a vehicle for mitigating societal challenges on the margins of Europe in the underserved northern, southern, western and eastern regions of the continent. A Europe-wide AMASS testbed of 35 experiments will be implemented in Malta, Portugal, the Czech Republic, Italy, Hungary, the UK, and Finland. The context of the design activity is the AMASS project involving the aforementioned seven European countries, and Sweden in addition; responsible for extensive literature collections and policy analysis. As an arts-based action research project, AMASS aims to create concrete opportunities for people to collaborate with artists as agents in creative projects. This multidisciplinary project involves a wide field of disciplines and participatory approaches for using practical methods from the field of arts and design to explore the role of the arts in mitigating societal challenges. It is aimed at capturing, assessing and harnessing the societal impact of the arts and generating social impact by identifying, exploring, collating, evaluating and analysing existing and new productions, experiments and case studies from the participating European countries.

The Art Writer Award for High School Students is an essay contest on art, hosted by the University of Tsukuba and endorsed by InSEA.

It allows students to develop the ability to convey their ideas and think about art in their own words. The 9th contest will be held for 2 years; essays in English in 2020 and essays in Japanese in 2021.

The total number of English essays submitted in 2020 was 147 from 24 countries and regions.

The Selection Committee announced the result of the Essays in English contest; two Grand Prizes, seven Awards for Excellence, and seventeen Winning Entries.
