



International Society for Education through Art Advocacy Award for Organizations

Deadline for Applications: February 14, 2025

The InSEA Advocacy Award for Organizations is presented to organizations that support the mission of InSEA— “the encouragement and advancement of creative education through art and crafts in all countries and the promotion of research and praxis about art education to foster international understanding”. This award recognizes the contributions of InSEA member organizations that have actively worked to further these goals. The InSEA Advocacy Award also serves as an incentive for cross-organizational collaboration, spotlighting contributions that align with InSEA’s mission.

Advocacy

- Global, national or local regional level
- Connecting action from the local to the global

Eligibility

- Advocating InSEA
- Advocating UNESCO goals
- Advocate to support the implementation of UNESCO Framework for Culture and Arts Education

If an organization that is not an InSEA member is selected for the InSEA Advocacy Award, it will be awarded an InSEA membership for one membership cycle.

Organization can be nominated by an InSEA member.

Nomination materials should be in English and include the following:

- Cover letter from the nominating InSEA member (Nominator) the candidate organization
- Nominator’s Name and InSEA membership number
- Date
- Nominator’s address, email address and phone number
- Name of the Nominee organization
- Acceptance letter from the nominee organization’s representative, with their signature
- Nominee organization’s contact email address
- Nominee organization’s official address
- Nominee organization’s official Phone number

All materials must be submitted electronically.



The InSEA Awards Committee consists of one Vice-President (Chair) and four InSEA World Councilors appointed by the President and approved by the InSEA Executive Board. The Committee will evaluate the submissions and make a recommendation to the InSEA Executive Board. The award decision will be announced at the World Congresses. The recipient will be in the InSEA Members' E-News and on the InSEA website.
