



InSEA Award for Excellence in Praxis in Education through Art

Application deadline for the world councillors: **February 14, 2025**

This award will be presented to an Art Educator or a Collaborative Group who:

- practices art education in schools, museums, other than higher education communities
- demonstrates that their praxis is aligned with the mission of InSEA to entitle all learners (regardless of age, nationality, or background) to access visual art education that deeply connects them to their world and to their cultural history that inspires knowledge, appreciation, and creation of new horizons that develop new ways of seeing, thinking, doing, and being (see InSEA Manifesto, InSEA Website)
- has demonstrated a commitment to multicultural and cross-cultural educational curricula in their schools and communities
- has demonstrated leadership
- implements pedagogical approaches that build respect for human dignity and diversity through art, and
- fosters teamwork, collaboration, and communication among diverse constituencies in order to achieve greater understanding of the social and cultural aspects of art and visual culture in education

Individuals and/or groups receiving this award must be members of InSEA at the time of receiving the award. Candidates meeting a minimum of two of the above criteria can self-nominate or be recommended by other art educators. Nominations should be emailed to the nominees' regional World Councilor. Individuals and/or groups receiving this award **must be members of InSEA at the time of receiving the award.**

The award decision will be announced at the Regional Congress or in the World Congresses.

The recipients will be announced in the InSEA News and on the InSEA website.

Nomination materials should be in English and include the following:

- Cover letter from the nominating InSEA member
- Nominator's Name and InSEA membership number
- Date

- Nominator's address, email address and phone number
- Name and title of Candidate
- Candidate's signature on a letter of acceptance
- Candidate's address, email address and phone number

All materials must be submitted electronically.

The InSEA Awards Committee consists of one Vice-President (Chair) and four InSEA World Councilors appointed by the President and approved by the InSEA Executive Board. The Committee will evaluate the submissions and make a recommendation to the InSEA Executive Board. The award decision will be announced at the World Congresses. The recipient will be in the InSEA Members' E-News and on the InSEA website.
