

InSEA Fellow Award

Deadline for Applications: February 14, 2025

The InSEA 'Fellow' Award is presented to artist-educators who have demonstrated *significant and sustained contributions* to the sector of art education that they work in.

Eligibility

- Nomination by InSEA member (no self-nomination)
- Nominee must have been exceptionally active in education through art for at least 10 years
- Nominee must be able to demonstrate a significant and continuing contribution to education through art
- Demonstrated leadership in the field of education through art
- Contributions are recognized in art educational contexts, such as art educational sectors in schools, museums, higher education, communities. Artists-educators might be independent artists, educators, or scholars

Conferment of fellow status will include:

- Printed certificate awarding the fellow status in recognition of contribution to education through art
- Invitations to contribute to roundtable discussions and surveys, giving the opportunity to influence and engage with education policy and have the fellow's voice heard by those making decisions at a system level
- Actively contribute to shaping the future of the profession

Commitments:

- Promote InSEA
- Give a paper, take part to a round table/panel discussion or give a talk in the future InSEA Congress and/or a Webinar
- Commitments co-opted by an elected body to support their work. Example co-op into review panels for awards

Nomination materials should be in English and include the following:

- Cover letter from the nominating InSEA member
- Nominator's Name and InSEA membership number
- Date
- Nominator's address, email address and phone number



- Name and title of Candidate
- Candidate's signature on a letter of acceptance
- Candidate's address, email address and phone number

All materials must be submitted electronically.

The InSEA Awards Committee consists of one Vice-President (Chair) and four InSEA World Councilors appointed by the President and approved by the InSEA Executive Board. The Committee will evaluate the submissions and make a recommendation to the InSEA Executive Board. The award decision will be announced at the World Congresses. The recipient will be in the InSEA Members' E-News and on the InSEA website.
