

Call for InSEA members' exhibition *Unexpected Territories* at the InSEA World Congress 2025

We warmly invite InSEA members to take part in a physical and digital exhibition, related to the World Congress in Olomouc, Czech Republic!

The theme of the exhibition is **Unexpected Territories**:

Through the image, we think and feel, through the image, we seek, find and express our identity, uniqueness, subjectivity – that is, our inner territory. Through the image we interpret and perceive not only ourselves, but also society, and the visible and spiritual world, too. How can this theme inspire you to make a piece of art?

Each InSEA member attending the World Congress is invited to bring a professional presentation of work. Works should be unframed, 2D works on a **firm** 30cm x 30cm board. The work itself can be smaller than 30x30cm, but if it is, it must be mounted to make the final dimensions 30cm x 30cm. Mounted works should be no thicker than 3mm with no protruding parts. Works should be neatly and securely wrapped in clear cellophane. All works must be clearly labelled on the reverse with the following:

If it is not possible for you to participate in person in Olomouc, we invite you to still participate in a virtual gallery, by sending in a digital image. The images will be presented in a rolling slideshow projected in the exhibition area at the Congress in Olomouc. The last day for submitting digital images is July 13.

Digital image submissions should not be larger than 5 MB, saved as LASTNAME_FIRSTNAME_InSEA_Olomouc, in the format JPEG or PNG. We do not accept Tiff, Psd or images in Word files. Upload your image here:



If you are visiting Olomouc in person, please hand in your artwork and the *Artwork release Form* (next page) upon registering in Olomouc. You are responsible to bring your artwork back from the

exhibition upon leaving the conference. The digital artworks displayed will not be saved for future use.

Please note that we cannot accept multiple submissions, it is a maximum of one per person. Please fill out the submission form on the next page to give InSEA the right to show your work at the exhibition. If your artwork should be damaged during the exhibition, InSEA cannot compensate you for that.
